

Homework Schedule

Essentially, for homework to be effective, it should support educational goals, take into account students' abilities and needs and strengthen the academy-home link.

Minimum weekly expectation:

Subject	Frequency
Mathematics	Once per week
English	Two pieces per week (<i>1 piece will be spelling</i>)
Science	Years 7 -10 – Once per week Year 11 – Two pieces per week (<i>1 piece will be revision</i>)
Drama and Dance	Years 7 – 9 – One piece per fortnight Years 10 – 11 – Once per week
Modern Foreign Languages	Two pieces per week (<i>1 piece will be spelling</i>)
Art	Once per week
Music	Years 7 – 9 – One piece per fortnight Years 10 – 11 – Once per week
Food Technology/Catering P.E/Health & Social Care	Once per week (<i>with the expectation that all students should be involved in extra-curricular</i>)
Technology (<i>all options</i>)	Once per week
History, Geography, R.E	Once per week
IT & Business Studies	Once per week

Guidance:

- Students that fail to complete and then submit a piece of homework by the agreed deadline, will be given a detention
- We expect all pieces of homework to be completed to the highest standard and presented as neatly as possible
