#### **Impact statement**

2016-2017 results for disadvantaged students shows the standard pass in mathematics and English combined is 56.1%, a significant rise in results from 40% in 2016. The progress 8 measure for disadvantaged students from 2017 results is now 0.1 showing students are making better than expected progress at John Whitgift Academy compared to 0 from the 2016 results which was still expected progress. The gap between other students is 7.7%.

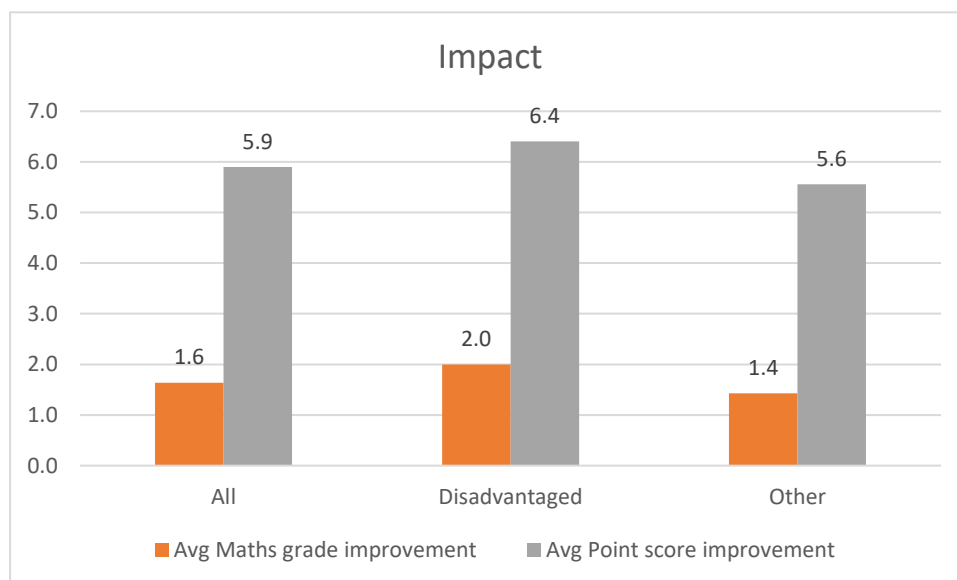

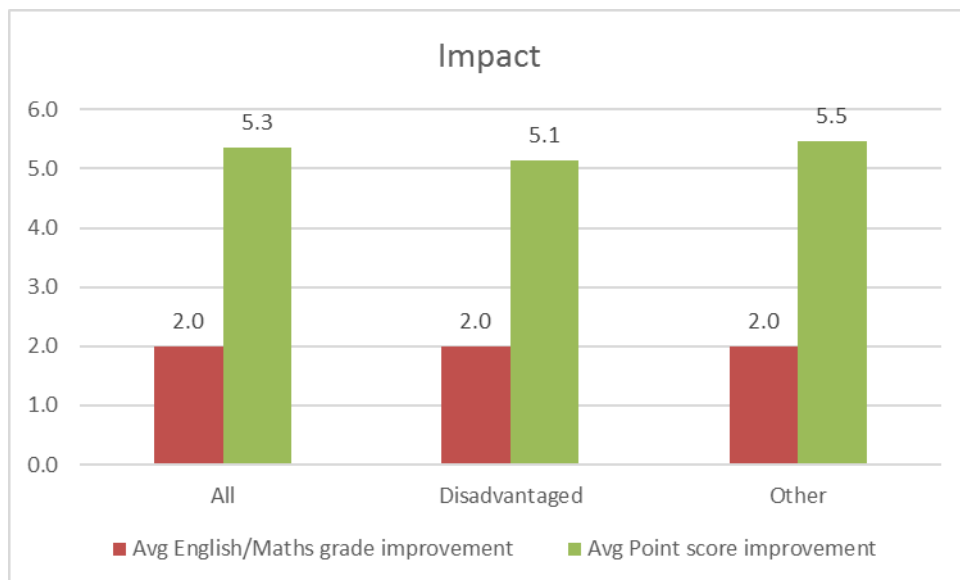

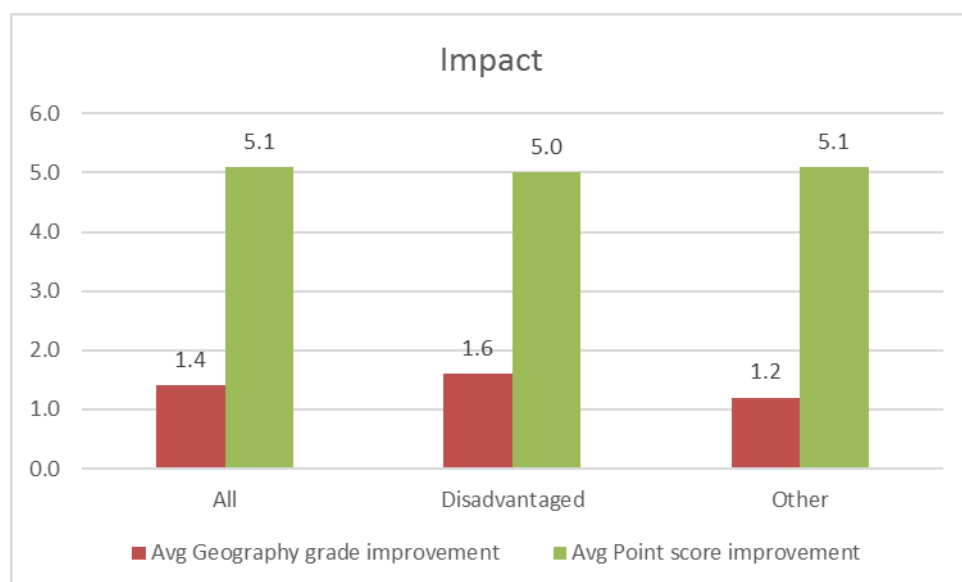
Provision consists of a one hour computer room slot in which students improve/catch up on any elements of controlled assessment they have missed. The sessions are by invitation and change depending upon need.

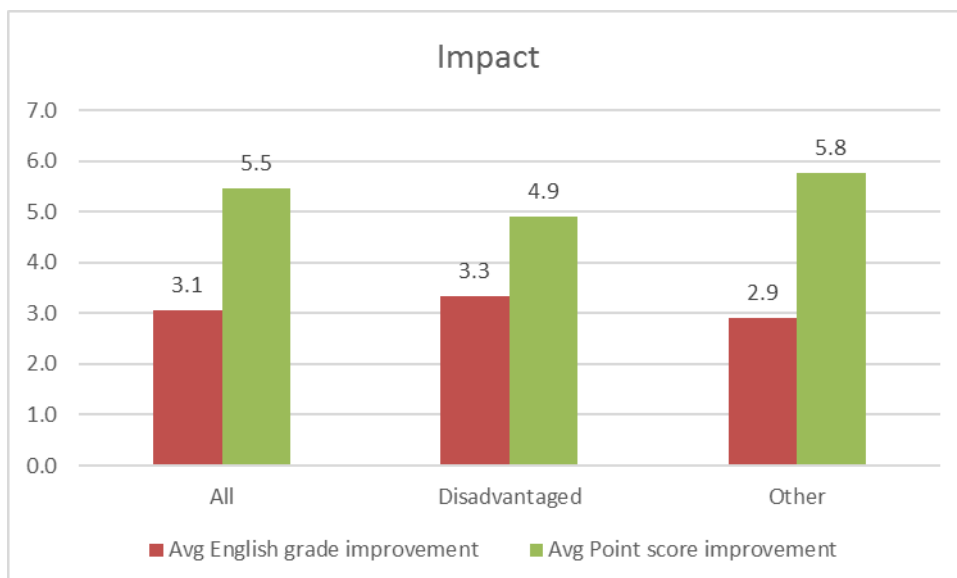

The students involved have one 1:3 session a week with LSAs during tutor time. During this time, they work on booklets designed for their specific need. Once they have completed the booklet, they move on to the one that meets their next greatest 'need', and so on.

This is to support students with achieving their full potential when it comes to sitting the new more scholastic GCSEs in English. Main class teachers collaborate with options English teachers to ensure the programme of study is tailored to the needs of the students. As well as focusing on spelling, punctuation and grammar, (worth 20% of the new Language and Literature GCSEs) students will focus on the 10 different components of Language and Literature which form the 4 GCSE exams: Reading 20th century Literature; prose writing; Reading 19th and 21st century non-fiction; transactional writing; Poetry; unseen poetry; modern prose/drama; 19th century fiction; Shakespeare and Spoken Language.
