UNIFORM

Bus passes will be removed from any student who misbehaves on the school bus.

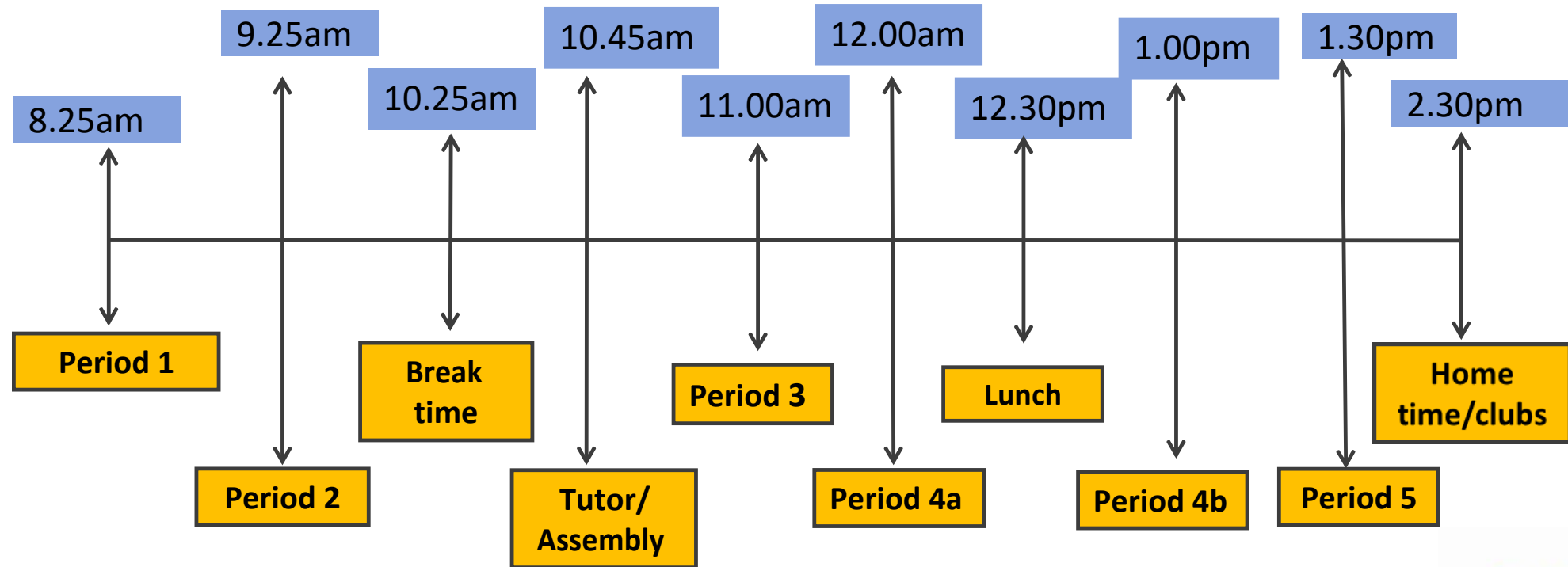
SCHOOL DAY
