**Subject:** Geography

<b>What can students do to further develop their skills in this subject area?</b>	
KS3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Know where countries are – It is important to know where countries are &amp; how there physical geography affects them.</li><li>- Watch the news – Take an interest in global events &amp; how they impact lessons</li><li>- Collaborative learning – Fully engage in group tasks – Could you taking a leading role?</li><li>- Challenge views/opinions in lessons – It is important to recognise different views.</li><li>- Consider how events in lessons affect you, your community &amp; the wider world.</li><li>- Participate in the fieldwork trips each year – You will get to see what we have learnt in the classroom.</li></ul>
KS4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Watch the news – Link global events to the case studies we have looked at.</li><li>- Understand the physical geography of countries – how does it link to the human geography?</li><li>- Deeper thinking – Link the topics we study together – how are some locations affected by different topics? Do hazards affect development?</li><li>- Critical thinking – Can you justify your argument? Discuss concepts with other people to hear their views – Are you able to acknowledge why there views and justify it.</li><li>- Know your case studies – You need to know the facts/figures for all of your case studies – this is the core information.</li></ul>

<b>How can parents/carers help and what can be done at home?</b>	
KS3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Encourage them to watch the news – Can they tell you something that has happened this week?</li><li>- Support them to use Globe &amp; know where different countries are located.</li><li>- Ask them to link there topics together – how does what they are doing now link to last week, or half term?</li><li>- Discuss how their actions affect other people – can they explain the social, economic &amp; environmental impacts of their actions?</li></ul>

KS4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Discuss the new with them – Make sure they are aware of current events around the world.</li><li>- Quiz them on location Geography – Do they know where countries are?</li><li>- Case studies – Test them on there knowledge of case studies – do they know the facts/figures.</li><li>- Encourage them to complete there forms quiz homework each week.</li><li>- Support them with revision.</li><li>- Challenge their views – Get them to justify why they are correct/their point is valid.</li></ul>
